How the Honors Program Works

- You must enroll in at least 1 Honors course per quarter.
- All Honors courses successfully completed will appear on your transcript as an Honors course.
- If you complete at least 6 Honors courses, your entire transcript will be designated as “Honors.”

Honors Program Requirements*

- A 3.3 GPA in high school or in 15 units of UC transferable college courses
- An SAT verbal score of 620 (550 if taken before April 1995)
- An ACT English score of 25
- * Even if you don't think you qualify but you're interested in the program, contact the Honors Coordinator to see what might be possible.

The Honors Program allows you to take challenging and engaging discussion-based core classes where you get more attention from the professor than you might ever get in a four-year institution.
