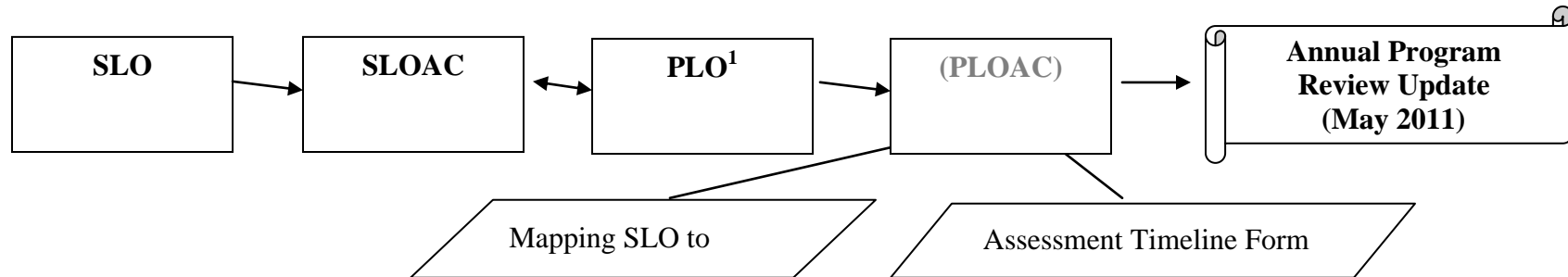
Date: February 2, 2011
