Requirements for Skills Labs: Students are responsible for completing four Skills Labs by Friday of Week 8.



Requirements to Pass Adjunct Skills 232/233 (1/2 unit Pass/No Pass):





Your final grade (Pass or No Pass) will be based on minimum attendance and percent of 180 possible points:
