1. Orientation (includes end of quarter Final Evaluation)	<b>10</b>
2. Group Sessions with tutor (8 to 9 group sessions offered per quarter)	<b>70</b>
• Each group session is worth 10 points	
• <u>Minimum of 60 group attendance points</u> (attend at least 6 groups) to Pass	
3. Skills Labs (4 labs offered; each lab is worth 25 points)	<b>100</b>
<b>Total:</b>	<b>180</b>

**Your final grade (Pass or No Pass) will be based on minimum attendance and percent of 180 possible points:**

A = 90 – 100%	D = 60 – 69%
B = 80 – 89%	F = below 59%
C = 70 – 79%
