## Meeting Minutes

1. Jefferson informed the group that Lenore Desilets tried having Math 114 students complete an online module before the start of the quarter
  - o 80% of those that did the module were passing with A or B
  - o 70% of those that didn't had non passing grade mid-quarter
  - o The module was self-paced and sent out about 4 weeks before class
  - o She used free trial version; if we adopted it, it would cost money (site license)
  - o Confounding factors: Perhaps the 80% that did well in the class are just more motivated
2. Doli updated the group on responses from the teaching assistant program
  - o Received from Karen Trayer, Lenore Desilets, Andrew Phelps
  - o Karen is coming under Enablemath and now has a lab tutor
  - o Lenore's class is hybrid: not funding hybrid for now
  - o Fund Doli and Andrew's classes
  - o We decided to inform the department about this before the start of the spring term, so faculty can plan this in their syllabus. This way we can perhaps get more faculty participating in this program.
3. Barbara informed the group that the cohort of Enablemath for next year with Anne is on track. Gregory will speak with Anne about supporting her work through Title III
4. Barbara brought up the idea of sharing innovative strategies with department. After some discussion, We decided on a retreat in Spring:
  - o Four workshops: 210, 212, 114, S-43

- Barbara will contact Loraine and Lisa – invite them for a brainstorming session
5. We discussed the Enablemath counseling situation:
- Counseling is no longer available for Enablemath
  - Jerry Rosenberg, Christina Espinosa-Pieb and Howard Irvin are looking for solutions, but could Title III be willing to fund this?
  - Gregory’s response: The institution has to figure out a way to fund this because this is an ongoing need. Title III cannot fund this on an ongoing basis due to the nature of the grant.
  - One idea: The S43 counselor can be rolled into Enablemath
  - Total cost to district for counseling component of Enablemath: \$60K-\$70K. But is that really the cost? Because some of the counseling that would happen in counseling happens in Enablemath. This way, the counselor is going to the students than the other way around.
6. Barbara brought up the idea of developing Review Modules, which has been floating around for some time in the Math department
- Barbara has spoken with Jerry Rosenberg, and Anne Leskinen was considered a good person for coordinating this effort
  - Any person coordinating this effort needs to see it from start to finish: research, license, lab set up, process for students, etc.
  - Plan: Barbara will talk to Jerry, Jerry talks to Anne, Anne works with committee
