

**Pacific Graduate School of Psychology
Bachelor of Science in Psychology Program
Transfer/Articulation Agreement
with
De Anza College**

De Anza College students wishing to transfer to the Pacific Graduate School of Psychology's Bachelor of Science program in Psychology and Social Action must successfully complete 90 transferable quarter units with a 2.0 GPA. (*De Anza courses numbered 1-99 are transferable to PGSP, with a maximum of 4 units from PE. Only courses with grades of C or better will be accepted, but all transferable courses will count in the GPA calculation.*)

Students must complete either the California State University General Education/Breadth (CSU GE Breadth) or the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC for CSU) requirements with a grade of C or better in each course. Either pattern satisfies PGSP's general education requirements.

De Anza students must also complete the following courses:

PSYC 1	General Psychology	4 Units
PSYC 2	Psychology as Behavioral Science & Profession	6 Units
PSYC 3	Human Experimental Psychology	6 Units

And a minimum of one and up to three of the following courses:

PSYC 4	Abnormal Psychology	4 Units
PSYC 6	Introduction to Humanistic Psychology	4 Units
PSYC 8	Introduction to Social Psychology	4 Units
PSYC/WMST 12	Psychology of Women	4 Units
PSYC 14	Developmental Aspects of Psychology	4 Units
PSYC/SOC 15	Basic Statistics & Research Methods in Psychology	4 Units

Students who transfer to PGSP will complete 82 quarter units of upper level courses in Psychology and the Social Sciences and 8 units of a required internship to satisfy the requirements for the Bachelor of Science degree.
