- 3) Review the SCU Admission Application (Common Application). Go to: <https://www.commonapp.org/CommonApp/default.aspx>  
 The SCU admission application must be submitted by **February 1, 2012** for a TAA. You must specify on your admission application that you are submitting a TAA in the "Additional Information" box found within the Common Application. If a TAA is written before the admission application is submitted (before February 1<sup>st</sup>), it will be held until receipt of the Common Application confirmation page. If the confirmation page is not received by the TAA deadline date, the TAA will be voided by De Anza. Once a decision is made, you will be notified by SCU Undergraduate Admission.

You must submit the following in order to complete your application for admission to SCU:

- Official copy of high school transcript (showing graduation date) and ALL college transcripts
- One College Instructor Evaluation (from Common Application)
- \$55 application fee

(Note: the College Official's Form and Secondary School Final Report within the Common Application are NOT required. SCU strongly encourages you to submit the Mid-Term Report, especially if you are interested in having current term grades considered. Although it is optional to submit a Mid-Term Report when applying, in some cases, SCU may require it in order to render a decision)

The minimum scores from one of the following exams are required: TOEFL (PBT): 575, TOEFL (CBT): 230, iBT: 90, IELTS: 6.5, iTEP: 4.5, Pearson: 61, or SAT Critical Reading: 630.
