

UC Riverside - Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)

Accepted year-round, but should be written at least two months prior to the UC application filing period for the desired quarter
For Fall 2010 – TAG must be submitted by October 16, 2009

To receive the TAG:

- You must be a US citizen, permanent resident or AB 540 qualified. International students are eligible to receive a TAG.
- All of your course work must be completed at a California community college.
- You must meet with a UCR counselor or representative.

The TAG is available for all majors.

To guarantee your admission to UCR you must *:

- 1) Complete at least 60 semester (90 quarter) UC transferable units with the required GPA for your specific major before transfer.
 - Achieve a minimum 2.4 GPA for majors in the College of Humanities, Arts, and Social Sciences (other than Business Administration)
 - Achieve a minimum 2.5 GPA for Business Administration and complete of ALL required courses necessary to satisfy selection criteria, as outlined on ASSIST (www.assist.org).
 - Achieve a minimum 2.8 GPA for majors within the Bourne College of Engineering and complete the engineering selection criteria as outlined on ASSIST (www.assist.org)
 - Achieve a minimum 2.7 GPA for majors in the College of Natural and Agricultural Sciences and be working towards completing MATH 1A, 1B and 1C.
- 2) Maintain good academic standing (2.0 GPA or higher) during your last full term of attendance before transfer.
- 3) Submit your UC application during the appropriate filing period as indicated on your TAG educational plan.
- 4) Apply for your contracted major** and for your contracted term.

* The UCR representative will fully define all TAG criteria during your meeting.

**If you plan to change your major after approval of this contract, you must contact a UCR counselor or representative.

How Do I Apply For A TAG?

- Download a UC TAG form from <http://uctransfer.universityofcalifornia.edu/>, complete the form (you do not need a counselor's signature), scan and e-mail it along with scanned copies of your transcript(s) and AP/IB exam scores, if applicable, to:
