^{*} The March 1, 2019 deadline applies to students who submitted their CSU Undergraduate Admissions Application for Fall 2019 and need to provide CSU with the ADT verification. If you applied to CSU for Fall 2019 (to a similar major) but did not indicate you were receiving this degree on your CSU Application, it is your responsibility to inform CSU campus(es) of your plan to receive the ADT at the end of Spring 2019. The verification deadline is March 15, 2018 (or earlier as directed by each CSU campus). Verification will not be possible unless all required conditions are met.

Degree applications received after the deadline will be processed to award the ADT.

[^] CSU minimum eligibility requirements for transfer include the completion of at least 45 quarter units of general education requirements with grades of "C-" or better. Individual CSU campus requirements may vary.

Complete a minimum of one (1) unit from each of three (3) different movement activity areas:

Aquatics, Combatives, Dance, Fitness, Individual & Dual Sports, Team Sports Note: For a list of approved courses, run a 'What-If' check on Degree Works

Political Science (AA-T)

Complete one (1) course: ADMJ/SOC 51, ADMJ/PARA/SOC 54, ADMJ/SOC 73, GEO 10, PSYC 1
