California Community College Recruiting and Subsidization Guidelines:

- All contact with a California Community College must be initiated by the student athlete. Contact from members of the community college coaching staff or their agent(s) are prohibited.
- Colleges **cannot** provide financial assistance/scholarships, housing or jobs.
- Coaches may provide advice regarding employment opportunities, matriculation, housing, financial aid, etc.

Financial Responsibilities/Guidelines:

- Out of State student athletes must pay non-resident enrollment fees until California residency is established. To establish residency, a student athlete must **continuously** reside in California for one calendar year plus a day. There are also other criteria associated with this process. - Student athletes may apply for financial aid, but there is no guarantee a student athlete will qualify.
- If a student athlete does qualify for Financial Aid, the grant does not generally cover all expenses associated with college, enrollment and living expenses. Students should plan to have another source of financial support.
- A general estimate of costs is provided below.
