There will be 9 quizzes (one for each chapter we cover) and I will automatically drop your lowest two scores.

### Extra Credit

Extra credit problems will be assigned for every chapter and are optional for students. The problems for every chapter are worth 3 points per chapter, for a total of 27 points for the course, and will be challenging. Extra credit problems will be available AFTER each chapter quiz and <u>are due at the beginning of the subsequent</u> class meeting (first 5 minutes of class), **no exceptions**.
