

#### Benefits of an Associates Degree

- Save thousands \$\$\$ on lower division coursework
- Insurance against life challenges
  - Course units expire (usually after 10 years), but a completed Associates degree is valid for life.
- An Associates Degree is a completed educational credential to put on your resume.
  - It prepares you for better jobs and internships.
  - It can help you to get pay raises at your current job.
- o Transfers with an Associates Degree have a higher chance of achieving their goals....

# What is a Transfer Degree (AS-T)?

- o About half of all Transfer Degrees awarded by De Anza are in Business!
- The <u>AS Degree for Transfer in Business</u> makes it easier for you to transfer to a CSU. (Link shows required courses.)
  - UCs and private universities also accept them. (Check with individual schools for specific requirements.)
- Completion of the AS-T for Business, guarantees priority admission consideration to the CSU system, though not to a specific campus.
- The degree gives you a special GPA advantage of 1 to 2 points when applying to a CSU-impacted campus or program (e.g. SJSU).
- You enter as a **junior** (3rd year) at the CSU.

<sup>\*</sup> In 2017-18, 341 Business AS-T awarded, constituted 47% of 729 transfer degrees (AS-T & AA-T), 79% of 460 AS-T degrees

### Benefits of the AS-T

- o It makes it easier to transfer to a CSU.
- Completion of the AS-T for Business, guarantees priority admission consideration to the CSU system, though not to a specific campus.
- The degree gives you a special GPA advantage of 1 to 2 points when applying to a CSU-impacted campus or program (e.g. SJSU).
- You enter as a **junior** (3rd year) at the CSU.

# What are the other Business Associates Degrees?

- The AA Degrees are more oriented towards getting a job immediately and transferring later.
  - They contain more business courses than the Transfer Degree, and prepare you better for an entry level job in your chosen career area.
  - The A.A. in Business Administration (general)
  - The <u>A.A. in Marketing Management</u> (for sales and marketing positions)
  - The <u>A.A. in Management</u> (for supervisory and management trainee positions)

# Business Administration is a general purpose major

- Many concentrations within Business Administration:
  - Marketing
  - Management
  - Accounting
  - Management Info Systems (MIS)
  - Finance
  - Operations Management
  - Human Resource Management
  - Entrepreneurship
  - International Business
  - Hospitality



# **AA in Management**

- Learn fundamentals of general business administration
- Prepares students for a career managing and leading employees
- Emphasis on management, leadership, and human resource management
- Positions such as:
   Service manager, retail sales manager, customer service supervisor, human resources coordinator, employee benefits associate, construction project manager, hotel/hospitality supervisor or management trainee

# **AA in Marketing Management**

- Learn the fundamentals of general business administration
- Emphasis on marketing, advertising, selling, international business, and social media.
- Learn how to create a marketing plan
- Prepare for careers such as: marketing events coordinator, retail sales manager, marketing communications associate, inside sales representative, sales specialist, and sales support specialist.

# Pathways for Degree Programs

### Recommended Pathways for Degrees

#### • Business Administration, AS-T or AA Degrees:

- 1. Take **Bus 10: Introduction to Business** and GE courses first.
- 2. Take BUS 18: Business Law and Accounting 1A: Financial Acct I (the prerequisite for 1B) and a GE course the following quarter.
- 3. Take Accounting 1B: Financial Acct II the quarter after Accounting 1A, plus other major courses from the degree list or GE courses.
- 4. Take Accounting 1C: Managerial Accounting the quarter after Accounting 1B, plus other major courses from the degree list or GE courses for the remaining quarters.

### Recommended Pathways for Degrees

#### • AA Degree in Marketing:

- Take Bus 10: Introduction to Business and Accounting
   1A: Financial Acct I (the prerequisite for 1B) and a GE course first.
- 2. Take BUS 90: Principles of Marketing and BUS 18: Business Law and a GE course the following quarter.
- 3. Take remaining major courses from the degree list or GE courses for the remaining quarters.

#### o AA Degree in Management:

- Take BUS 10: Introduction to Business and BUS 65: Leadership and a GE course first.
- 2. Take remaining major courses from the degree list or GE courses for the remaining quarters.

# How do I request my Degree?

- When you are nearing completion of your coursework, follow the instructions on the counseling web site and fill out the application for an Associates Degree.
  - The short form asks for the courses you took, and the last ones currently in progress.
- There is **no charge** or fee to get an Associates Degree along with the units for transfer,
  - Only the cost of courses taken.
- You must request the degree.
  - De Anza will <u>not</u> automatically provide it, even if you took all the necessary courses!

# Certificate Programs

#### What is a Certificate?

A certificate program is generally used to show a significant block of course work to employers.

They are shorter than Associates degrees

At De Anza, you can earn certificates while working towards an associate degree, often without taking any additional courses!

There is no extra cost or fee to get one.

Only the cost of courses taken

- They can qualify you for better jobs, even if you are still in college.
- They can help you to get pay raises at your current job.
- A Certificate in Management can qualify you for a position as supervisor.
- A Certificate in Entrepreneurship can make you and your business more appealing to investors and partners.

### How do I request a certificate?

When you are done with the courses on the certificate:

- Go to the counseling web site and fill out the <u>Certificate Application Form</u>
- 2. Drop it in the A&R drop-box.
- 3. You will get email confirmation within 72 hours.

You <u>must request</u> the certificate to get it. De Anza cannot automatically send one to you.

- Take Bus 10: Introduction to Business and Accounting 1A: Financial Acct I first.
- Take other Bus courses and choices the following quarter(s).
- o **Entrepreneurship**:
- Take Bus 55: Intro to Entrepreneurship and your choice of BUS electives first.
- Take **BUS 58: The Business Plan** the quarter after BUS 55, with remaining electives.

- Take Bus 10: Introduction to Business and BUS 90: Principles of Marketing first.
- Take other courses from the certificate list the following quarter(s).
