- Lydia Hearn from the Honor Programs comments that she will be passing around a packet that has all the information of what this programs do and offers to the students. They have showed constant growing with serious students who would like to join this program. A lot of students who are in this program are being accepted into really high end UC and they feel they are helping out a lot of students.
- Diana Argabrite from the Euphrat Museum of Art comments that they first invite everyone to the event that they are having on Thursday, February 9th, 2012 to see what the museum is all about. Diana Argabrite would also like everyone to take a look at the fact sheet, which is being passed around to everyone also. They museum is something that is very important to many people and students and should not be taken for granted, this place helps students on so many levels and students play a huge role in this place. She would like everyone to know that if there is no funding to this program or place there would be really no way in keeping it going and they are more likely to go dark. Any money from DASB would help in any form or way.
- Nicky Gronzalez Yue from Campus Wellstone/DLTP comments that they are happy from all the support that has been given to them by DASB Senate. The training that is offered at this program helps forms leaders and gives really good training. They work with all types of students, from high school or college level, they help with giving students a voice and makes them feel as if they have a voice that can be heard. Some students look forward to going out on this trip, to get away from all that is bothering them, as they can connect more and get more into the training. To do this on campus and away from campus can make a huge difference to most people.
- Diana Alves de Lima from the Student Success Center comments that a sheet is being passed around, it is full of facts and everything that they help with. The Student Success Center and Torturing Center help all the students of De Anza College in some form or way. They would like to grow, but know that the DASB Senate is working on more of keeping things the way it is. The reason they are asking for more than they usually do is because their title 3 grant is ending and they need money to help replace that money that they will be losing. All the money that they get from DASB goes right to Student Tutoring and nothing else. Out of this program, students are getting a lot of skills and both the tutor and the student are learning from each other.

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- David Buyer from the Library comments that their items on check out help out the students in more ways than one. They have about 3,042 books on reserve and they are helping out a lot. Professors have donated books to help with their own classes. They thank the DASB senate for all the support that is given to them.
- Wilfredo Castano from the Photography Department comments that the funding in the past has helped a lot and just a little bit more money can help with buying some things they need.
- Alicia Curtez from the Puente Project comments that they have been around for 11 years and their program has been a big success and they thank everyone for all the funding they have been getting. This program helps a lot of students and makes it feel like they have a family here at the school.
- Joc Lipsis from the Computer Donation Program comments that they would like to thank everyone for all the support they have been giving. They have trained many students who they help in the program, and with all the work they do they are able to donate computers to many needing families.
- Carmen Pencida from Cal-Works Textbook comments that their program gives out book vouchers to their students. They thank everyone for their work and their continuing work. In this program the students have four years to finish their studies and during that time they have to get a job at the end of it also It helps them get started.
- La Donna Yumori-Kaku from ICC, New Student Orientation and Summer Program comments that for ICC they can not express how much clubs means to colleges and that clubs help this school in so many ways and students. On behalf of the ICC they would like to thank everyone for all the support that they have been given.
