Description: Campus Facilities will be presenting the current plans of Measure G as well as collecting student feedback on the project.

- ⇒ Jennifer M: Measure G bond update and master project list which can be found online. Some projects in progress are the fire alarms and suppression systems and the new service student building. You can track all this information in the bond revisions to see progress on projects. Projects, for example, request approval for a proposal and then are approved by the board of trustees. Sometimes they require a site investigation. Along the way, budgetary concerns and reviews will be conducted. Another project is modernizing the building's interior and exterior. There are multiple phases for projects such as programming and market analysis. The Flint Center, which is being replaced by the events facility, was suggested by the Board of Trustees to meet the needs of a cultural venue and civic conventions. You can check out the Facilities Master Plan. The mega project consists of renovating, taking down, and constructing.
