# **Approval of Minutes**

Wednesday, February 13, 2002

Leila Forouhi, from the Earth Renaissance Club, commented that many programs shouldn't be asked to fundraise, as their main source of funding.

A student representative commented that in his many social dance classes, he has noticed an increase in enrollment, and thus a performing arts hall would be beneficial.

Rashaun Vance, commented that SLAMS, STARS and Outreach programs encourage the students on campus and give them direction and support.

Roshan Pourabdollah, the ICC chairperson, commented that the money that was freed up last week should first be spread out over the diversity programs, and if there was money left over it should be allocated to ICC.

Wilfredo Castaño, from the Photography department, commented that the money that was requested would provide for replacements for the aging equipment used by the department.

Deborah hill, from the Dance department, was in favor of the performance hall.

Janna Morgan, former DASB VP of Administration, read her letter aloud, as a handout.

Cynthia Kaufman, appreciated the good job last week, and urged for consistency to support the diversity programs.

Judy Mowrey, from the Open Media Lab, commented that 5,000 students every quarter utilize the lab for 30,000 hours. And the requested funding was for additional computers, to replace the aging Macintoshes.

A student representative from STARS, appreciated the support last year, but next year there will be more students that will require even more help.

Sergei Fyodorov, from the Theatre Arts program, commented that they need a new room for the audience to come to see the performing arts.

Carmen van Gastel, from Altrans, commented that they need money to survey the students that will utilize the program to carpool.

Rob Mieso, a SLAMS Coordinator, appreciated the hard work last week, and commented that students are successful because support and help are provided.

A representative from STARS and SLAMS appreciated the work done last week, and commented that everyone should remember the stories from last week.

Diane Foster, a representative in favor of the performance hall, commented that it necessary for future performances.

Paul Rodriquez, Jr., from the Dance Theatre department, commented that theatre and dance are important even though they might not be taken seriously.

A student representative, from the Dance Theatre department, noticed that coming to De Anza from Foothill, she noticed that people join theater and dance, despite all the drawbacks. And they need a performing hall to perform their craft.

A representative from STARS, commented that STARS and SLAMS affect too many students, and they provide a necessary support system to many students.

Grace Chung, from La Voz, commented that even though diversity is an integral part of De Anza, La Voz is one of the few programs that represents all students.

Adrienne Hypolite, from DLTP, read her letter aloud, which has handed out.

A STARS representative commented on behalf of all diversity programs, where the money that is necessary for them to run is being cut.

Robert Haugh, former Editor-in-Chief of La Voz, commented that the La Voz budget requests is only for printing, which is directly handed out to the students of De Anza.

A STARS representative, commented on the myths of diversity programs.

A STARS representative commented on the retention of the students and the facilities they provide is for teachers and support.

An advisor for diversity programs commented on the direction and support that they provide for students.

Leslie Walker, from DLTP, commented that DLTP deals with racism and teaches real-life issues.

A DLTP representative appreciated the past funding but commented that the proposed budget does not divide the money equally.

Sara Albertson, from the Theatre department, commented that a performance hall will not only support the arts, but will provide an example for numerous other campuses to follow.

### **Burning Issues**

Jittaun Batiste appreciated the audience for showing up, and commented that some people live diversity every day.

Sulaiman Hyatt appreciated the audience for keeping him company this week and last.
