# House or Committee Challenge

Whereas Senators are primarily students and role-models, who's eligibility and desire to participate in our organization is dependent upon the culture we create together; the DASB Senate resolves to institute a system to promote a positive working and cohesive environment by tracking the contributions of our committees' members and provide incentives for them to strive for the greatest excellence possible.

Points will be tallied monthly between committees, with rewards and consequences based upon their relative totals. The two lowest scoring committees will take on the monthly task of vacuuming the senate and wiping the tables, among other approved consequences. The top scoring committee will earn the privilege of skipping their next weekly cleaning duty, among other approved rewards.

Additional rewards currently under consideration are: Trophies, Prizes, a La Voz advertisement featuring the committee's excellence, etc. Failure to comply with consequences (but not by virtue of having them) may be considered a failure to fulfill a duty required by one's position, and therefore could accrue an absence.

DASB Executives, Judicial Board Justices, and our advisors can present cases to award and deduct points at the Exec meeting. Execs are allow to award points to all committees but they are only deduct points from their respective committee. The points will be posted in the office and will be updated weekly.

#### Ways to Earn Points for your Committee

- 1. Accomplishing tasks assigned to the committee by governing documents, the DASB Senate, or the Executive Advisory Committee.
- 2. Have the highest average (current) GPA (as a committee) (Note: GPA will be noted by our advisor only and will not be directly revealed. Only the ranking of GPA between committees will be revealed by our advisor).
- 3. Best committee attendance.
- 4. Most committee field hours completed beyond the minimum specified by the Bylaws.
- 5. Winning DASB Olympic events
- 6. Recruiting students to join the Senate or Clubs
- 7. Improvement in behavior
- 8. Good acts

#### Ways to Lose Points for your Committee

- 1. Being verbally, physically, or emotionally abusive; providing criticism alone without providing constructive suggestions; intentionally embarrassing another person in public for one's gain.
- 2. Late on deadlines (may be continuously applied each day or week the deadline is missed, depending upon urgency)
- 3. Skipping classes without medical reason nor having instructor's permission 4. Being tardy to or absent from appointments or meetings.

Note: Senators who are members of multiple committees will have their actions reflect upon the original committee for which they are a member.

Issue: What student concerns do you feel the DASB should address?

It seems that the most common concern amongst the students is the new Myportal. A lot of people seem to have problem with trying to log into it because it either keeps crashing or freezing on them. Because of all these problems with the myporatal, the students have to stand in a huge line in order to talk to admins. The DASB can help with that by getting everyone to vote on the parcel tax and using that money to get more admins to help the students. Another concern amongst the students is that there are not enough counselors, which could also be solved by getting the people to vote on the parcel tax. Another concern that the students have is that there are not enough parking spots in the parking lot. More concerns that the students had were that the bathrooms are too dirty, the food prices are too high, there are not enough spots in the classes, and the book prices are too high. Some more things that the students have concerns with and want are bus passes/eco passes, a new field and track, more student aid, lower parking fines, and less difficulty with processing with paperwork. It seems that most of these problems could be fixed with getting people to vote on the parcel tax.
