- Adam Coquia from the Marketing Committee pointed out that they had difficulties advertising the Tailgate party that took place on Saturday, November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2010. He also announced that the committee had come up with more details for the Pepsi Refresh video by writing 2 scripts.
