- Kevin asked that if this is for stabilization, was there need of this when the dot com bubble crashed?
- Bret said no it wasn't used then. Revenue went up because fees have increased.
- John said if this passes a few other things need to happed: By Laws need to be changed to allow
- Then get to Bryan Murphy's desk so it can be voted on in March.
- Lisa said she has never seen the Restricted Reserves used before.
- John said Finance must deal with this on Monday, then get it over to Admin and have it on next weeks' Senate Agenda.
- The last time to put something on the Board is the last week of February.
- Kevin moves to drop the restricted reserves \$500,000 to \$470,000 and start the Eco Fund with \$30,000 for the 2015-2016 Budget.
  - Second by Quang
- Kevin said this is a big responsibility and we need to be held accountable and he wants everyone to understand.

- Kevin amends to use a stipulation to take \$30,000 from the revenues generated by an increase of \$1 to the DASB membership fee in the year of 2016-2017, if the Eco fund is successful and the increase of \$1 to the DASB Membership Fee is passed by the 2016-2017.
- Kevin removes his amendment from the Senate Floor.
- No objections to the removal of Kevin's proposed amendment.
