#### "To all:

It is with great sadness that I am basically forced to resign from DeAnza Senate due to circumstances beyond my control. Being part of this group was without question a most important, enjoyable, and valuable endeavor. The friendships I have made with many of you was the best part of De Anza for me. I can only hope we will not lose touch. I wish you all the very best and great success with the Senate's goals and activities. I am very, very sad to resign.

Even though I was videotaped by Thao last week while I was in physical rehabilitation, I was very emotional and using medications for foot pain which did not allow me to articulate all the pertinent reasons I have to leave De Anza.

Obviously, continuing my physical rehabilitation after my foot surgery is one reason I am not returning to De Anza this fall.

The primary reason, however, is that I could never get essential academic accommodations I require from DSS to execute class assignments and exams for every class, which compromised my academic performance and created so much stress daily for me. I tried for 2 years consistently to work with DSS, requesting repeatedly what I required and proven by documentation when I first registered. I was usually ignored or DSS delivered whatever they wanted, never the form of accommodations that actually work for me.

After meeting with Dean Stacy Cook in early July and explaining in detail the problems and providing suggested solutions, she committed to investigate and respond to me the week of July 17, but I never received any communication from her at all until after I emailed her on Sept 20 2015 to notify her I could not return to De Anza College and risk further damage to my academic record. Basically, she indicated nothing would be done differently. That means I cannot execute academics the way I am legally entitled to.

I share these details with the Senate for one reason only -- something needs to be done. It is not just me that DSS is ignoring or shoving out of De Anza. All students should be treated as if they matter. And for students with disabilities, a college education is our only ticket to have a shot at life on our own terms. And it's a rough road. DeA nza's DSS does not comply with federal law, it's that simple. I wanted to be an agent of change through DASB and work to get DSS to respect students with disabilities and to respect federal law. But unfortunately, my education will be further harmed if I stay.

Most importantly, I was humbled and honored to be part of DASB.

I am heartbroken to say the least.

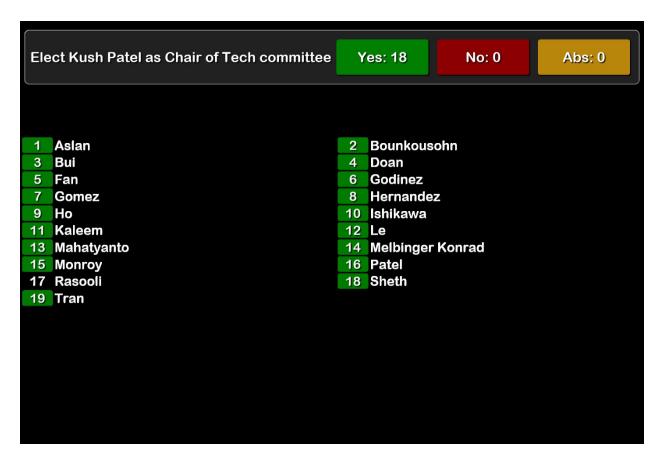
