

earliest registration time possible.
































OP, I completely agree with you.

I eventually found classes elsewhere, and although they're a lot more expensive, at least I know the administration is willing to increase the class sizes for those on the waitlist or waiting to register.






Hi, how do you create a form like this. I think there is also a high demand for phy4C this quarter.


This is also my third year in De Anza, my registration time was at 9 am. I am not able to take




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














Priority Registration


I was excited for my classes just yesterday seeing that I had a great plan, but before I could even pick half of my classes I wanted were all taken and completely closed.


Gives specific information on when students are able to sign up.
