

## **2023-2024 DASG Budget Guiding Principles**

<u>Required:</u> The programs requesting funds from the DASG directly affect De Anza students except for recruitment programs conducted by DASG Constituents at De Anza College for prospective DASG Constituents.

- Fund programs that help students succeed and enable them to achieve their academic and personal goals at De Anza College.
- Fund programs that promote leadership, civic engagement, and student advocacy among all students.
- Fund programs that promote diversity, equity, and inclusion among all students.
- Fund programs that follow environmentally sustainable practices.
- Fund programs based on the current value and needs of the program rather than solely on historical funding trends.
- Fund programs that benefit students during the 2023-2024 fiscal year.
- Fund programs that benefit DASG Constituents.
- Fund programs that promote student retention by enhancing the quality of education at De Anza College.
- Fund unique programs that fall outside the purview of what should normally be funded by the college. Fund programs that support student activities and enhance the student cocurricular/extracurricular experience. In other words, fund programs that are not considered essential programs and services for students as those programs and services are the responsibility of the college to fund. Essential programs and services include, but are not limited to, Tutorial Services for

Students, Transfer Counseling Services, Athletics' Entry Fees and Referees, etc.
