PROPER DISPOSAL GUIDELINES



BROKEN GLASSWARE BOX

- ⇒ Dispose only **broken and clean** glassware in this box.
- ⇒ **Do not** dispose any regular trash in this box such as paper towels and gloves.
- ⇒ **Do not** dispose broken glassware that is contaminated in this box.
- ⇒ **Do not** throw away any equipment unless allowed by the instructor.

SHARPS CONTAINER



- ⇒ Dispose **small**, **contaminated**, **and sharp** objects in this container.
- ⇒ Needles, razor blades, pins, used slides, coverslips are disposed in this container.
- ⇒ **Do not** dispose any regular trash in this container.



BIOHAZARD CONTAINER

- ⇒ Dispose **infectious waste** in this container such as bacteria contaminated plastic Petri plates, gloves or paper towels.
- ⇒ Dispose **preserved specimens** in this container such as (fetal pigs, rats, sheep eyes, sheep brains, sheep kidneys, owl pellets, fish, blood, etc.)
- ⇒ Dispose **broken AND contaminated** glass in this container.
 - ⇒ **Do not** dispose unbroken glassware in here.

PROPER DISPOSAL GUIDELINES



LIQUID HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION JUG

- \Rightarrow Dispose **liquid hazardous waste** in this container.
- ⇒ **Do not** dispose bacterial cultures in this container.
- ⇒ **Do not** dispose preserved specimens in this container.
 - ⇒ **Do not** dispose any solid biohazard in this container including micro-centrifuge tubes.
