



Guidelines for nursing student clinical rotations at El Camino Health

1. These guidelines are subject to change based on County of Santa Clara, city or hospital changing conditions.
2. Students will not be assigned to airborne isolation patients.
3. We will be **requiring** Covid vaccinations for instructors and students starting this fall. By signing and submitting the nursing student documentation verification form, the school is stating that they can provide proof of Covid vaccination documentation for students and instructors.
4. For instructors and students not vaccinated, the school must find alternative clinical placements for them.
5. The first time the students and instructor comes to the hospital they will have to go through the screening station at the front main entrance. Proof of Covid vaccination will be needed to gain entry into the hospital. Once they receive their ID badge they will be able to enter and be screened on the unit.
6. All students and instructors will be required to monitor themselves for signs and symptoms of Covid-19. Wellness monitoring forms will be provided to you (the instructor) to have students and instructor fill out every day you are onsite for clinical. Subject to change.
7. No more than 3 students will be allowed on one unit/department at a time. (Nursing clinical groups may consist of up to 10 students, but they will need to be assigned to different units)
8. No students will report to clinical if they are sick or exhibiting any of the specified symptoms. Student is responsible for following their school's process for calling in sick. Please inform the nursing student placement coordinator of any students who were sick and couldn't attend clinical onsite.
9. All students will be required to wear a hospital provided surgical mask and hospital provided safety eyewear or face shield when on nursing units. Masks are worn at all times except while eating meals.
10. When communicating with managers or preceptors, please CC the nursing student placement coordinator on the email to keep the coordinator in the loop.
11. Nursing Capstone/Senior Preceptorships will be allowed, subject to availability and strongly encouraged to be on the off shifts (evenings and nights).
