

## DRAFT Financial Aid Scholarship from the De Anza Academic Senate

- **Description:** Intended for any De Anza student who is committed to their educational goals and needs a little monetary help to achieve those goals.
- **Qualifications**
  - De Anza student
  - 18 units
- **Application questions:** Answer only those that you feel comfortable answering
  - Required yes/no questions:
    - Are you experiencing housing and/or food insecurity?
    - Are you or have you been involved in the criminal justice system?
    - Are you balancing school with a full-time job and/or parenting or childcare responsibilities?
    - Are you or your parents undocumented?
    - Are you a foster youth?
  - Optional short answer questions. You are encouraged to answer at least one of these questions, but none of them are required.
    - Would you like to expand on your answers to any of the yes/no questions?
    - Declared major
    - Future educational plans (at De Anza or another college)
    - Are you on academic probation and, if so, what is your academic plan to get back into good standing?
    - Accomplishment at De Anza that you are most proud of?
    - How would this scholarship help you stay in school and achieve your goals?
    - Is there anything you wish to share?
- **Award amount:** up to \$1,000
- **Number of recipients:** 2 @ \$1,000 and 3 @ \$500
- **Deadline to apply:** April 30, 2023
- **Date to open applications:** March 1, 2023?
