### <u>Reports</u>

- Byars reported Equity Action Council (EAC) opted to do the By Stander Training instead of their regularly scheduled meeting. Myra Cruz is leading activist efforts for Puerto Rico because they are still without power, water, and other necessities. The Student Voices United For Change Conference was on March 16<sup>th</sup>. The theme is Building Community for Student Empowerment. Registration closes March 12<sup>th</sup>
- Maynard reported IPBT is reviewing programs for their effectiveness, productivity, and the health of departments and divisions. They are still in the initial work and will be making recommendations for

- viability. There is an extended meeting on March 9 to meet with programs.
- Maynard reported Academic Senate did a 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of the low cost resolution for books for online students. She clarified the resolution called for a \$50 maximum for textbooks per course. This includes online and printed textbooks. Academic Senate is also looking into FSA areas and rights to teach in a different area.
- King reported the Classified Senate Committee for the Ice Cream Social and Donation had a meeting tomorrow.

#### Accreditation Follow Up Report

Newell gave an Accreditation Follow Up Report. There were emails sent to Faculty to update, finish, or fix their SLOs. The Dean's reviewed the submitted SLOs and then the SLO Core Team reviewed them again to make sure everything was correct. To prove substantive interaction for online courses instructors wrote narratives describing the substantive interaction and courses will be farther along next time the accreditation team visits. The accreditation team will return April 26<sup>th</sup>.
