Student Statistics

- * Program began in 1961 at Foothill College but moved to De Anza when it opened in 1967
- * Enrollment 2015-2016 was 1788 students
- * **Success rate 85%**
- * Of those who succeeded last year 100% received their RN license
- * **Equity gap – 9 percentage points**
- * 47% of all students enrolled identify as African American, Latino, Pacific Islander or Filipino
- * 57% of students came in with HS or equivalent

Job Outlook

- * There will be far more registered nurse jobs available through 2022 than any other profession, at more than 100,000 per year.
- * With more than 500,000 RNs anticipated to retire by 2022, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics projects the need to produce 1.1 million new RNs for expansion and replacement of retirees, and avoid a nursing shortage
- * The fastest growth for RNs' employment is projected in the West and Mountain states

Nursing Program

- * **2 year/ 6 quarter program.....** at the end of which students who successfully pass/ graduate receive :
- * an **AA degree in Nursing** and
- * after taking the licensing exam – a **RN in Nursing**

Nursing Teaching schedule

3 days a week which includes

- * **6 hours lecture/day; once a week**
- * **7.5 hours clinical rotation/day; twice a week**
- * During clinicals – faculty are responsible for **overseeing students in the clinical setting** as well as **making decisions about and maintaining standard of care for patients** – who are often acutely sick and frail.
