### From spring 2011 to spring 2012:

#### Resident and Non-Resident Enrollment

- Total resident and non-resident WSCH is down 2% at 251,018.
- Total resident and non-resident unduplicated headcount is down 1% at 21,292.
- Resident WSCH is down 3% at 217,172.
- Non-resident WSCH is up 2% at 33,846.

#### International Students

- International students with F1 or FZ visa status increased 6% from 1,709 to 1,816.
- Female international students decreased from 49% to 47% while males grew from 51% to 53%.
- Top countries of origin for all international students includes: China, Hong Kong, Indonesia, India, Japan and South Korea.

#### Distance Learning

- Total distance learning estimated WSCH is down 5% at 19,988.
- Distance learning headcount is down 4% from 3,444 to 3,300.
- Distance learning course enrollment is down 8% from 5,149 to 4,742.
- Distance learning sections offered is up 7% from 134 to 143.
