Subject: First Year Learning Experience Learning Community, Fall 2010 Survey Results

The First Year Learning Experience Learning Community survey was administered at the end of the fall 2010 quarter to 108 students enrolled in Introduction to Sociology. This resulted in 30 valid responses for a response rate of 30%.

The survey responses show the respondents are benefiting both academically and socially from their participation in the FYE learning community. Two areas for improvement which received the highest rate of 'rarely or never' responses include discussing academic and career plans with a counselor or academic advisor and discussing personal, family or other non-academic issues with a counselor.

The overall positive findings show:

- Ninety-four percent of respondents often or very often connected and integrated ideas, concepts or skills from different classes when discussing material or doing assignments.
- Eighty-six percent of respondents agree or strongly agree that they are better at using student services, such as counseling, because of FYE.
- Ninety-three percent of respondents agree or strongly agree that they are more successful in their classes because of FYE.
- Eighty-six percent of respondents often or very often report putting more time and effort into class work because they did not want to let down their classmates.
- Ninety-three percent of respondents agree or strongly agree that they have more confidence in their academic abilities.

Areas for improvement include:

- Forty percent of respondents rarely or never discussed academic or career plans with a counselor or academic advisor.
- Seventy percent of respondents rarely or never discussed personal, family or other non-academic issues with a counselor.
