
A survey was sent by faculty to students of De Anza College enrolled in the Nursing Program during the Spring quarter 2011. A total of 142 students responded to the online survey.

Important highlights include:

- 96% of respondents "agree" or "strongly agree" that the amount of work required for this course was appropriate for the credit received.
- 91% of respondents "agree" or "strongly agree" that the course objectives were clear.
- 89% of respondents "agree" or "strongly agree" that the assigned reading and A.V.s for this course were appropriate.
- 88% of respondents "agree" or "strongly agree" that objectives of the course were obtainable.
- 87% of respondents "agree" or "strongly agree" that the required textbook for this course was helpful for meeting the objectives.
- 86% of respondents "agree" or "strongly agree" that the complexity of the course was appropriate for this level; and the out-of-class suggested reading and A.V. assignments were accessible.
- 78% of respondents "agree" or "strongly agree" that the out-of-class assignments (e.g., A.V., group activities, etc.) were relevant to the course objectives.














