SUBJECT: Nursing Program Theory Survey, Winter 2009

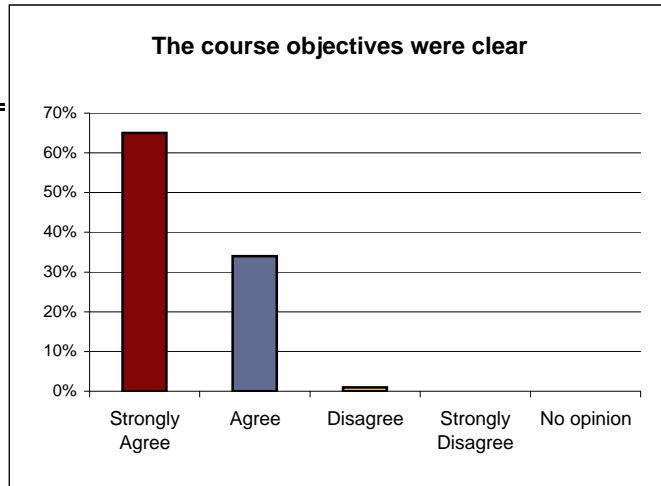
A survey was sent to students of De Anza College Nursing Program during Winter quarter 2009. A sample of 368 students responded to the survey.

Important highlights include:

- 99% of students “agreed” or “strongly agreed” that the course objectives were clear and obtainable.
- 97% of students “agreed” or “strongly agreed” that the required textbook for the course was helpful for meeting the objectives.
- 94% of students “agreed” or “strongly agreed” that the out-of-class assignments were relevant to the course objectives.
- 97% of students “agreed” or “strongly agreed” that the tests in this course related to the course objectives.
- 90% of students “agreed” or “strongly agreed” that the assigned papers for this course contributed to the achievement of course objectives.
- 96% of students “agreed” or “strongly agreed” that the course has helped them to improve in clinical performance.
- 95% of students “agreed” or “strongly agreed” that compared to other courses in their major, they would rate this course as effective.

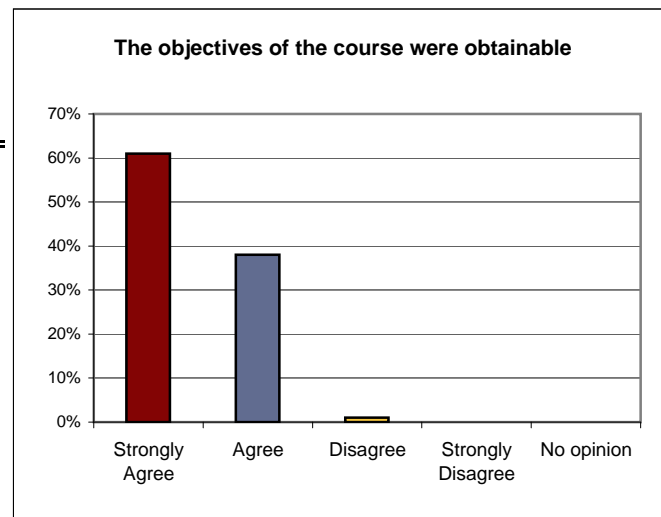

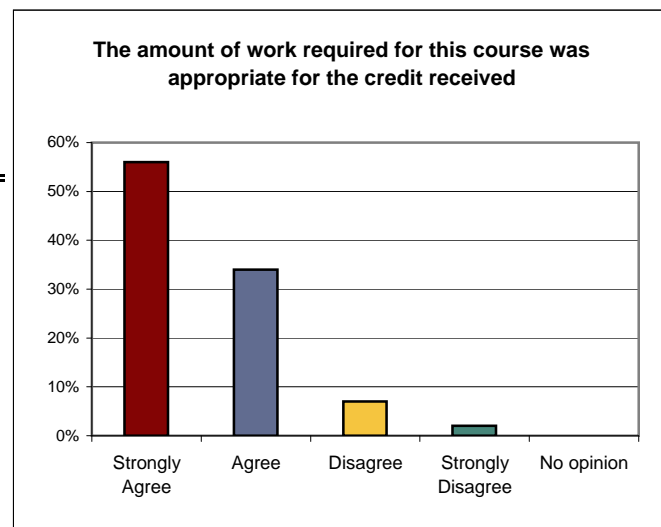

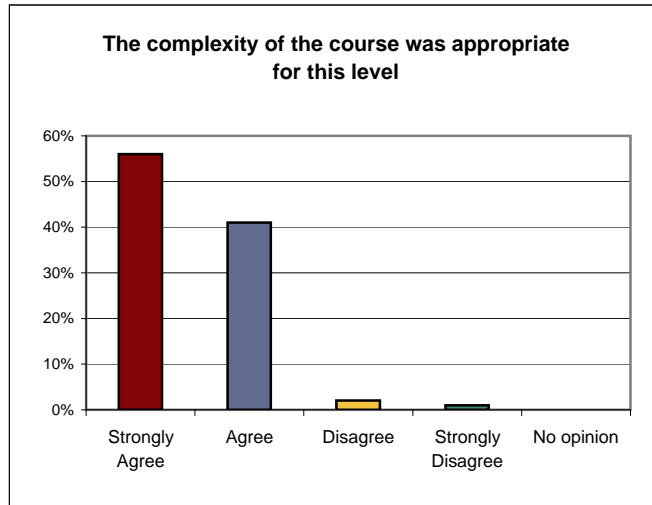
3. The amount of work required for this course was appropriate for the credit received

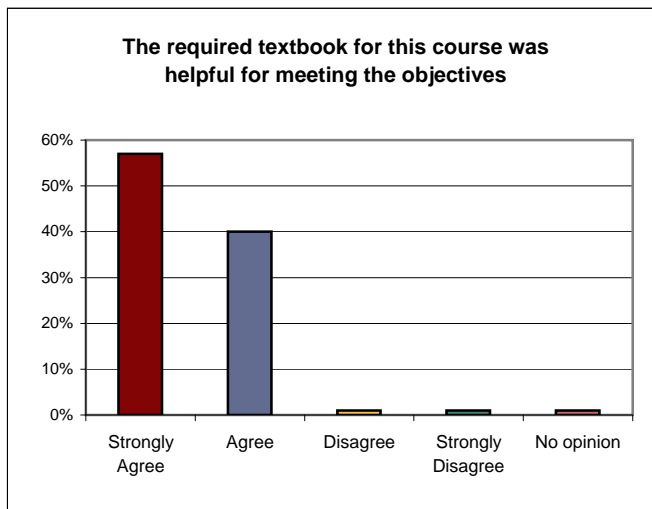
4. The complexity of the course was appropriate for this level

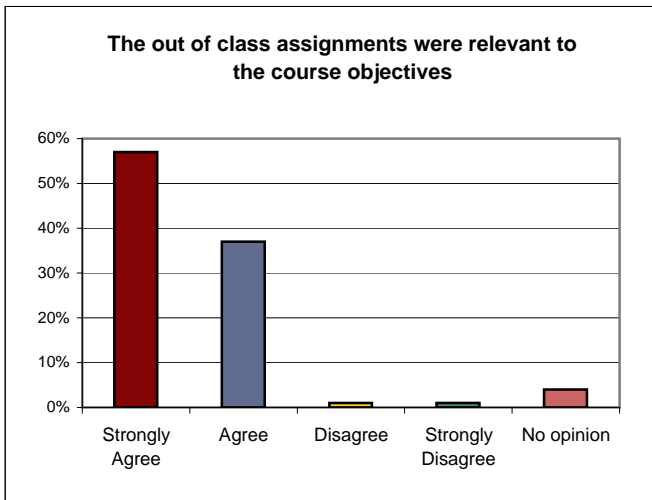

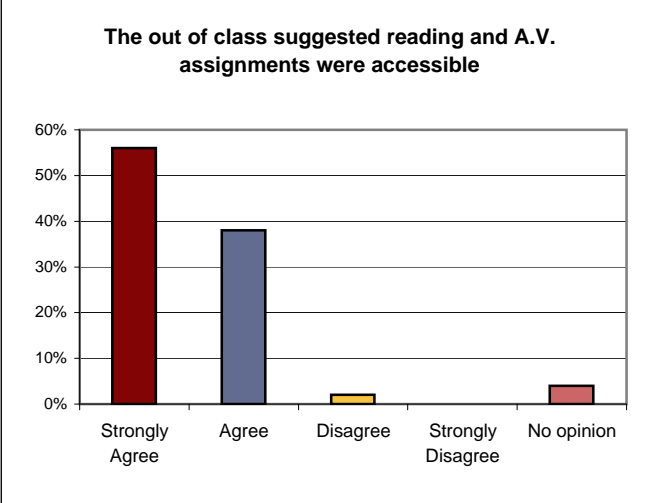

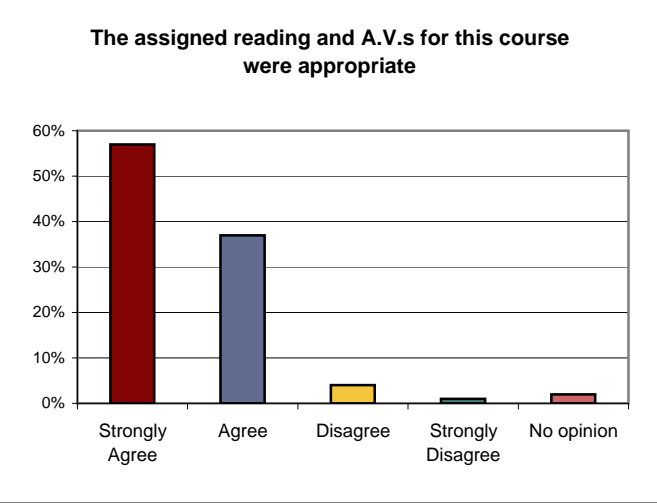

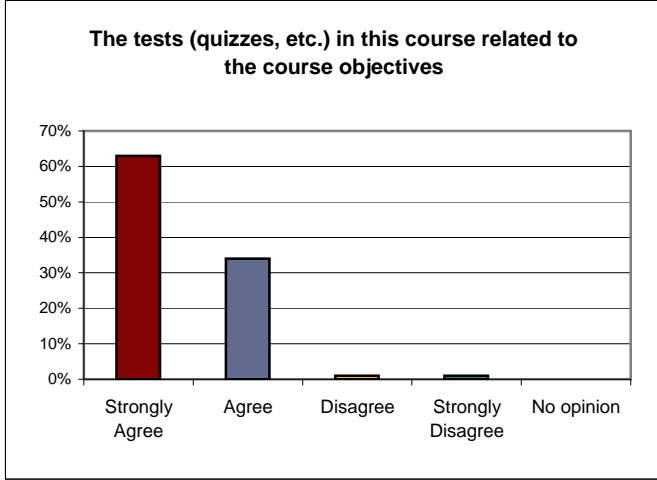

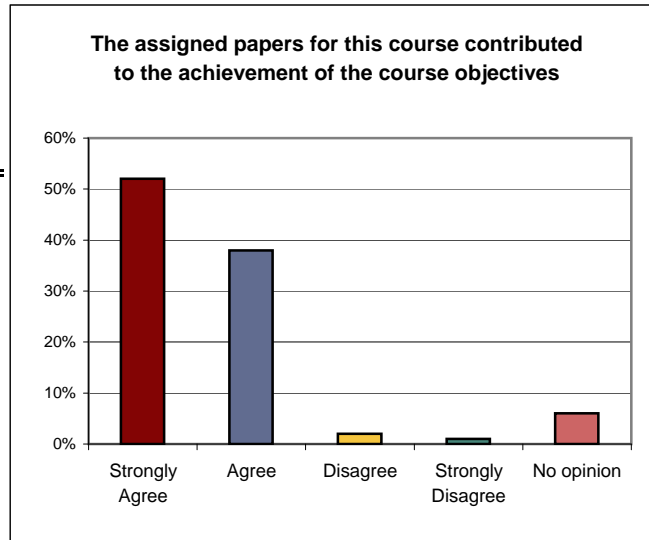

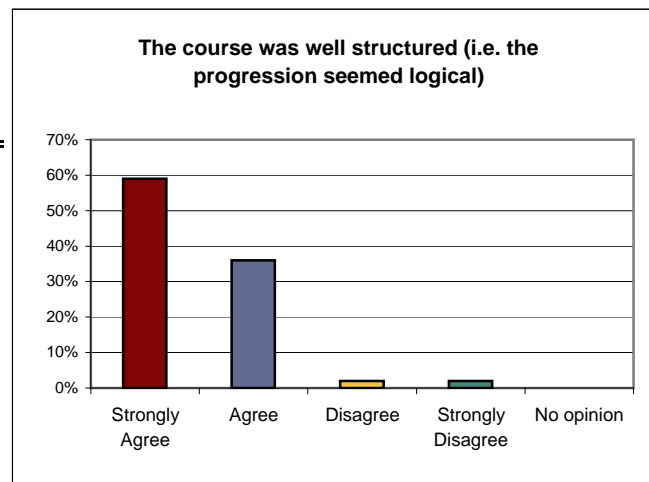

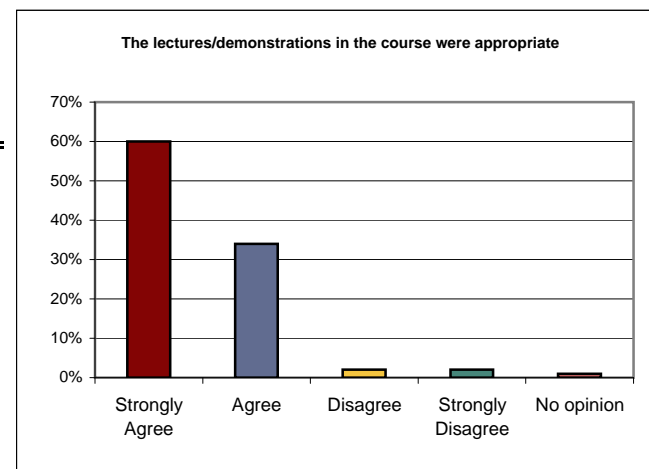

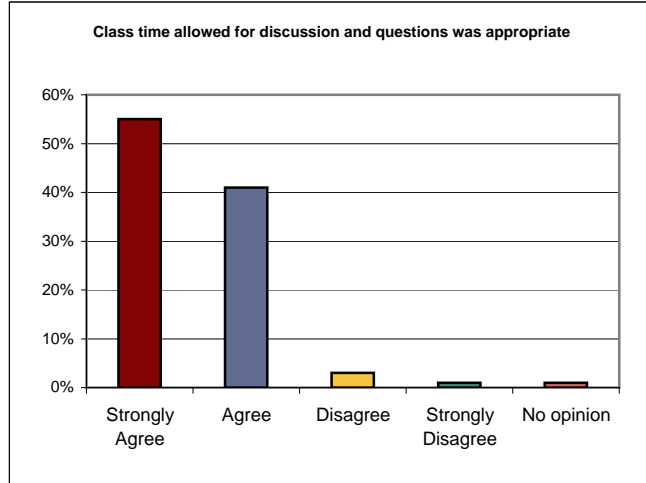

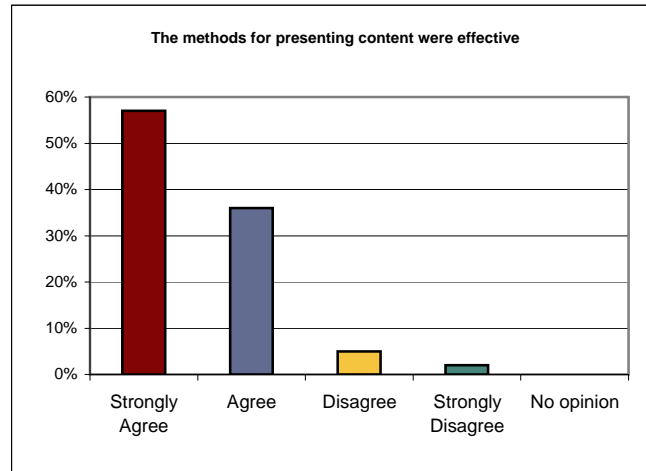

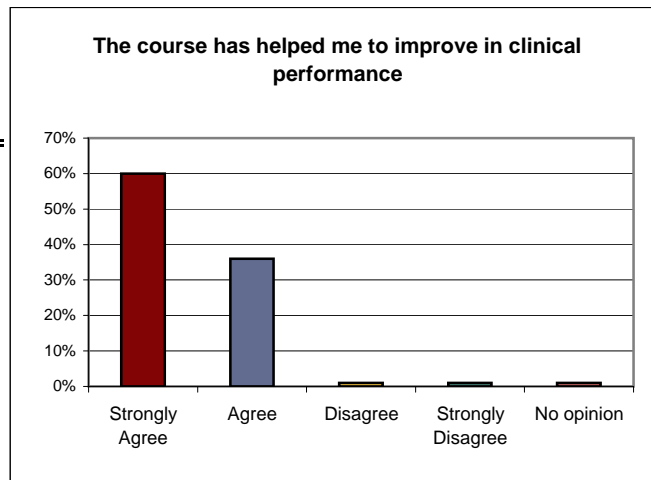

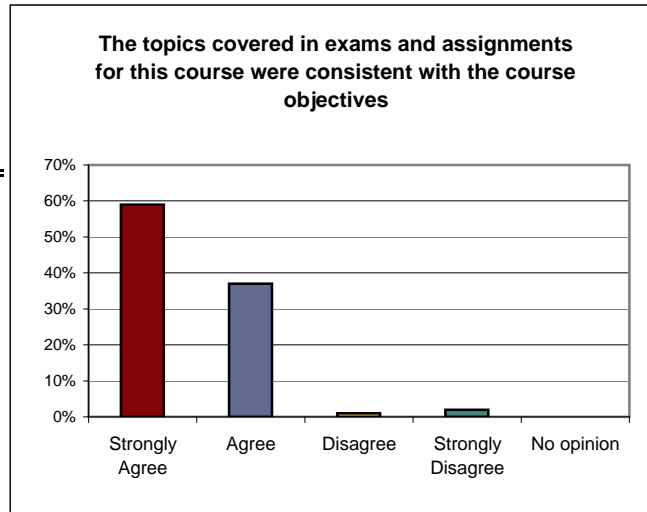
