

Split a movie into clips

You can split a movie into as many clips as you like. After you split a movie into clips, you can rearrange them.

Choose View > Show Clips.

Move the playhead (the red vertical line) to the place where you want to split the clip (or use the Touch Bar), then choose Edit > Split Clip.

Your movie splits into two clips. Repeat until you have as many clips as you want.

When you're finished, click Done.

Rearrange movie clips

After you split your movie into clips, you can rearrange them however you want.

Choose View > Show Clips.

If you have only one clip in the movie, there's nothing to rearrange. You need to first split the movie into clips.

Drag the clips into the order you want.

Add a new clips

Open the movie that contains the clip you want to add, then choose View > Show Clips.

Select the clip, then choose Edit > Copy. The selected clip is outlined in yellow.

Open the movie that you want to add the clip to, then choose View > Show Clips.

Choose Edit > Paste. The clip appears at the beginning of the movie. Drag the clip to rearrange it.
