Course Description

Introduction to the discipline of music; methods of understanding music available in modern culture; listening techniques; use of fundamental concepts including form, style, musical media, and textures; acquaintance with and comparison of musical examples from various eras and cultures; roles of music in society.

Learning Outcomes and Objectives

- Employ a basic vocabulary of common music terms to describe observations of recorded and live music.
- Recognize individual instruments and voices and the various ensembles in which they are used.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the roles of music in human cultures and relate musical expression to other forms of artistic expression and to culture generally.
- Distinguish features of important musical style periods, forms, composers, and practices.
- Recognize, describe, and compare musical practices in contemporary society.
- Recognize basic distinguishing characteristics among a representative group of musical compositions.

ASSIGNMENTS

Readings

The assigned readings should be completed using the SmartBook on Connect. It will pair the reading with relevant exercises to help solidify the concepts.

IMPORTANT: The content of the SmartBook and the traditional book or eBook are the same. Completing the SmartBook assignment replaces reading the traditional text. <u>Independent reading of the text to</u> review concepts is also encouraged, but for this assignment to be fulfilled, the Connect portion with <u>questions must be completed</u>.

Reviews and Quizzes

Reviews are exercises completed in Connect that will reinforce important concepts and prepare students for the exams and Quizzes. Quizzes are assigned weekly and should be completed in Connect.

Critical Listening

Listening is one of the most important aspects of this course. Throughout the textbooks, students will be exposed to listening guides that will point out relevant features of a given piece that will enhance one's understanding of it. Connect has a plugin that will point out these features in real-time as the example is played. Critical listening assignments will test students' knowledge about the repertoire covered in the textbook.

Journals

Journals are assigned for each new subject in the course. This portion is completed in Canvas and is not related to Connect. The goal is for it to be a place of open discussion where students and instructors interact and share their experiences in appreciating music.

IMPORTANT: Each student is expected to select a piece of music relevant to the subject being studied. They should listen to this piece and share their impressions based on the concepts learned throughout the course. Each student is then expected to respond to two entries by their colleagues. Specific guidelines for each journal can be found on Canvas.

PERFORMANCE REPORT

All students are expected to attend one classical music performance and complete a performance report. This performance can be a Symphonic concert, an Opera, a Ballet, a Chamber Music concert, or a Solo concert. Prior to attending the concert, students must complete a check-in (available on Canvas) to make sure the concert they plan on attending is a valid option.
